

The fees listed here apply to the September 2025 and March 2026 groups and will not change (i.e. won't be increased once the course has started), so you can plan ahead with a high degree of certainty. If you are looking to start later, in either September 2026 or March 2027, scroll through this document to the appropriate section.

The standard fee (for Option 2) for these groups is:

- First year - £7,671
- Second year - £7,671
- Third year - £8,902 (including six months of one-to-one clinical supervision)

There are three payment options then:

**Option 1 – Full fees paid up front each year – this option carries a 3% discount\***

After this, refunds are calculated on a pro-rata basis.

- any course books you wish to buy (*note that you will be provided with the majority of texts you will need as part of the course fees\*\*, so there will be little to spend on books unless you want to. You will also be provided with a scrubs top and point location dividers*)
- clinical supplies for home practise
- travel, food and accommodation, where relevant
- additional private point location practise on occasion
